### **ODM** prepares for end of PHE

The Ohio Department of Medicaid has indicated that the public health emergency (PHE) may end in January. The PHE provided an increase in federal matching Medicaid funds if the state was willing to maintain people in Medicaid despite changes in their eligibility. Ohio has done this during the PHE; therefore, there are some Medicaid recipients that may no longer be eligible. Once the PHE ends, the state has to "unwind" those that are enrolled by doing eligibility redeterminations. To prepare for this, ODM has created a toolkit for providers to educate Medicaid

### PNM training for phase III

From ODM: Provider Network Management (PNM) training sessions begin on October 24 in preparation for exciting changes coming on December 1. Registration is available now in the <u>Learning Management System (LMS)</u>, <u>Absorb</u>. The <u>training schedule</u> has been posted and is available on the <u>Next Generation website</u>.

Training module topics will include the following:

- Self-service Hospice.
- Fee-for-service and Managed Care Claims Submission (Dental, Institutional, and Professional).
- Fee-for-service and Managed Care Prior Authorization Submission.
- Fee-for-service and Managed Care Eligibility Inquiry.
- Fee-for-service and Managed Care Claims Inquiry.
- Fee-for-service and Managed Care Provider Financials/Remittance Advice.
- Cost Report Submission Process via Ohio Medicaid Enterprise System
   (OMES) Cost Report and Rate Setting Web Portal for Long Term Care (LTC),
   Hospital, Medicaid School Base, Federal Qualified Health Center (FQHC),
   Rural Health Center (RHC) and Outpatient Health Facility (OHF) Providers.

#### LMS registration

In preparation for the December 1 launch, we are offering a variety of training options including self-paced, virtual, and in-person training options. Absorb, the Learning Management System (LMS), is where you will access the self-paced training and sign up for the virtual and/or in-person sessions. If you do not have an account in the LMS, it's important that you create one to ensure you have access to all training sessions, answer forms, and a variety of PNM resources. Access the job aid and follow the steps to create your account and register for training.

#### PDPM transition discussions continue

ODM continues to meet with interested parties regarding the transition to PDPM for determining the case-mix score to set rates. The group reviewed the necessary rule and statutory changes to implement PDPM. The goal would be to pass the statutory changes in the upcoming budget bill and then the necessary rule changes. The first rate setting under PDPM would be Jan 1, 2014. The group also further discussed the benefits and concerns of only using the nursing component to determine the CMI. Initial analysis of the change suggests some providers could see a significant change in their Medicaid rate. Further discussion is scheduled for this week. (Back to top.)
